As requested I have reviewed the Constitution and By-laws for the Cerle Creek Summer Home Tract Association. I am somewhat confused as to whether or not this Association intends to incorporate since the word "Inc." appears in parenthesis after the title. There is no objection, of course, to such an incorporation if it desires to do so.

Thile the organization is called an Association, apparently changes were made in certain corporate papers and the words "Corporate" and "Corporation" were used in several places. I have circled these places and suggest that they be changed to "Association".

There is an ambiguity in the fourth paragraph of Section 1 of Article III which should be cleared up. I believe the intention is to restrict the amount of indebtedness against the Association to \$500 unless the members have approved a greater indebtedness. Some additional words seem to have erept in.

The second paragraph of Section 3 of Article V is ambiguous. The paragraph has reference to assessments levied against the mamber, and then states that no assessments which exceed \$500 total against the Corporation (Association). This abould be clarified.

This Constitution and By-laws are rather elaborate, but this does not render them objectionable.

#### Dear Permittee:

A review of our files indicates that you were never notified that the Gerle Creek Summer Home Association's request for recognition as an approved Summer Home Association was granted by the Regional Forester in August of 1966. Your Summer Home Permit is in one of the tracts that the Association represents. Indeed, most of you are already members of the Association.

There are many values that a formally recognized Summer Home Association gains. These benefits are for the general good of the permittees of the tracts represented by the Association. Only a recognized Association is required to be consulted and informed by the Forest Service on those things which have a general effect upon a special use permit.

Your Association now has the ability to provide services, which are for the general benefit of the permittee and to require that the permittees of the area that receive this service must pay their fair share of the cost of the service. When the service is of a type approved by the Regional Forester, the Forest Service supports the Association in requiring that the service will be used and paid for by the permittees in the area served. For example, if the Association provides garbage collection service, the permittee in the area served by this collection must use the service and pay their individual cost.

You are not required to join the Association or to pay dues; this is an individual choice. But the individual, whether a member or not, is required to pay the assessment for services provided by the Association as described above. I feel that most of you will find that there is a value to be gained in being a member of this Association. This is the only way that you can participate in the decisions that are made.

Attached you will find an amendment to your Special Use Permit which reflects formal recognition of the Gerle Creek Summer Home Association. Please attach this amendment to your present permit.
